**Victory Parade in Moscow
Displays Vast Red Might**

Russia hails victory in Moscow's Red Square, largely restored since the Nazi bombings of 1942...With The Red Star triumphant in the war on the **WESTERN FRONT**, Marshal Josef Stalin arrives to preside over the celebration, a week before V-Day...That gives you some idea of Russian confidence.

To his accustomed reviewing stand atop the tomb of Lenin, where he gives the signal starting the first May Day military pageant in four years - No longer is it the "International" to which they march, but the stirring strains of the New Soviet Anthem.
