Date & Location: STUDLAND BAY. 20th June 1945.

Assignment: BEACH FLAME DEFENCES IN ACTION.

Footage: 400' Light conditions: Poor.

Scenes:

(1) Undersea jets in action. These jets are concealed under the surface about 50 yards from the beach and are electrically ignited transforming sea into sheet of flame.

(2) Beach jets in action. These face out to sea, and are concealed on beach at intervals of ten yards, creating a barrier of flame.

Remarks: This material consists mainly of close-ups, supplementary to Mr. Prosser's general views.

Date & Location: STUDLAND BAY. 20th June 1945.

Assignment: FLAME THROWING BEACH DEFENCES.

Footage: 440' Light conditions: Bad.

Scenes:
