DESCRIPTION : After debarking at the port of Antwerp, the President and his party drove to a British airfield several miles outside of Brussels where they boarded C-54s to continue his trip to Berlin for the big three conference. These pictures were made at the airport and shows the presidential party. (The Presidential Secret Service Guard put considerable restrictions on photographs and as a consequence the story is limited. President Truman reviewed the guard of honor which was composed of the 137th Regt. 35th Div. which is the division from Prdsident Trumans own state---Missouri.
