

FUTURE BUILDERS LEARN THE ROPES

Under way as part of the National Housing programme is a Government sponsored scheme ⁴ of intensive training ¹ for building apprentices. Until thousands of building operatives have been demobilised there are not enough men in the industry to train the required number of apprentices in the ordinary way. At more than thirty centres up and down the country the Training council is getting the boys ready to join private firms as soon as house-building starts on the grand scale. At these places the youngsters get the benefit of expert training in far shorter time than apprentices in pre-war days. Millions of houses are wanted as soon as possible. The Government hopes that in one way and another a hundred-and-twenty-five-thousand boys will be trained for the industry in the next five years.
