- Shot 1. After arriving at the island the Jap Commander-in-Chief came aboard to meet Captain (D) E. C. MacGregor with Colonel Andrews, U.S.A., Major Black, U.S.A. The Jap is Colonel Sato.
- Shot 2. The party arriving on the island making their way towards the Jap H.Q.
- Shot 3. Arriving at U.S.A. H.Q. in the prison camp.

Roll 2

- Shot 1. The P.O.W's quarters which housed the Australian P.O.W's.
- Shot 2. The Indian quarters, showing groups of Indians pleased to meet some of the people who they have missed.

Roll 3

Two Indian Officers. Jack Moran from Victoria a prizefighter, now in a poor state of health. Shots of wards where dysentery has caused many P.O.W's to die.

Roll 4.

P.O.W's walking cases going aboard Jap L.C. to be taken by transport to Hong Kong, Dutch, Indians, Australian.

Roll 5.

A Dutch soldier dies on the day the hospital ship arrives to take him away.

Roll 6.

Shots of stretcher cases being taken aboard hospital ship. Australian, Dutch, Indian.
