MANY ANIMALS ARE LIKELY TO BE SENT TO THE LONDON ZOO FROM KENYA IN THE NEAR FUTURE. MR C.S. WEBB WHO IS REPRESENTING THE LONDON ZOO SAID IN AN INTERVIEW "FOR THE FIRST TIME IN SIX YEARS THE WAR DEPLETED STOCKS OF THE LONDON ZOO ARE GOING TO BE REPLENISHED AGAIN FROM KENYA. I HAVE ALREADY A BABY ELEPHANT, A BUFFALO, TWO LEOPARDS, ONE LION, A COUPLE OF IMPALA, A WARTHOG, AN ORYX, FIVE GALAGOS, TWO GIRAFFES AND VARIOUS ANTELOPES. I HOPE TO BE OFF WITH MY 'LIVE' CARGO WITHIN A MONTH."

ARRIVAL OF CONSIGNMENT OF ANIMALS FOR LONDON ZOO.
