

THE CROWN PRINCE OF YUGOSLAVIA

CHRISTENING IN THE ABBEY

The christening of the infant Crown Prince of Yugoslavia took place yesterday at Westminster Abbey in the presence of the King and Queen, King Peter and Queen Alexandra of Yugoslavia, King George of the Hellenes, Princess Elizabeth, the Duchess of Kent, Princess Alexander of Greece, Prince Tomislav of Yugoslavia, Princess Helen of Serbia, Princess George of Greece, Princess Eugenie Radziwill, Prince Vsevolode and Princess Romanov-sky-Pavlovsky, and Lieutenant-Com-mander Prince Dimitri.

The King and Princess Elizabeth were god-parents and the infant Crown Prince received the name of Alexander.

The ceremony was conducted by the Patri-arch Gavriilo, Bishop Nikolai, the Metropoli-tan Germanos, and Father Nikolic, in the pre-sence of the Archbishop of Canterbury, the Dean of Westminster, and the Archpriest Theokritoff.
