Canada's fishing industry has become a godsend for starving Europe. From British Columbia's icy coastal waters come most of the world's salmon. Two months out of the year, salmon by the hundreds of thousands are caught and sent throughout the world.

Within twenty-four hours, these salmon will be cleaned, canned and cooked. Eighty per cent will be sent to Europe.

This year's catch is a two hundred per cent increase over nineteen forty-four's. Canada's salmon catch will save many lives in Europe this winter.
