All this is seen in a glittering new plastic bouder designed by Rohm & Haas, makers of Pleniglas. In the air-conditioned sleeping section, even the mural is Pleniglas.

Plexiglas, developed during the war, has not been available to civilians before now. It can be malded at lew temperature glassiand out with a saw. Designs carved on its surface glow with light when the panel is lit from the edges. Plexiglas is lighter than aluminium, and almost impossible to break. On the hat-tree in this dream-suite, there's even a selection of plastic bats.
