COMPLETE DESCRIPTION OF SCENES

The procession of the Leaders from All Souls' to the Sheldonian Theatre, in pouring rain.

General Eisenhower, in his robes of a Doctor of Civil Law, waves to crowd.

The scene through the open doors of the Sheldonian Theatre with the dignitaries of the University awaiting the arrival of the procession.

The procession entering the Theatre, in the rain.

Interiors. The scene in the Theatre as General Eisenhower receives his degree.

Mr Winant, the U.S. Ambassador standing as the Public Orator reads the eulogy.

Various general views in Theatre.

Exteriors. General views of the Sheldonian Theatre. (In very bad light and rain).

N.B. Due to the weather the procession through the streets was cancelled and they walked only some thirty yards in pouring rain.

For adequate coverage two silent men were necessary. After making poor exterior coverage it was almost impossible to fight my way back into theatre where stairs to gallery were jammed with people. Due to extreme cold outside and very high temperature inside my lenses were steamed up for a considerable time, after eventually reaching my position in gallery. It was impossible to alter my position for other general views or cut ins in Theatre due to hundreds of extra people having forced their way into stairways and galleries.
