The Armistice Day Ceremonies were marked for the first time with homage rendered to the bodies of 15 French war heroes, two of them women, as the bodies were laid in State at the Arc De Triomphe besides the "Unknown Waldier" of World War 1.

The Ceremony was presided by General Charles de Gaulle, not yet elected Chief of the French Government.

French troops marched around the monument and French planes flew over at low altitude.
