PUNISHMENT FITS CRIME

Jap General Yashamita, charged with mass murder in the Philippines, faces the death penalty before an American Commission in Manila. Justice moves swiftly.

The mosquito ridden island of Rampang is the destination of the Singapore Jap garrison. Daily, in batches of a thousand, these Nipponese go into exile to pit their warbound wits against the elemental force of Nature. For one hundred and twenty thousand of them Rampang island will become a camp of their own making, built with shovel, adze and tree axe.

Nature provides the materials for their shelters; wood for the framework and bark for the tiles, and the jungle itself provides a fitting background for the one time gaolers of Malaya.
