1. TITLE: ATTLEE, TRUMAN FACE PEACE PROBLEMS
2. Washington---Prime Minister Clement R. Attlee arrives from England, and is welcomed by <sup>American</sup> State Secretary Byrnes. No stranger to Washington, Mr. Attlee has been here three times since 1941.
6. At the White House, he sees President Truman for the first time since the Potsdam Parley. Their meetings concern world affairs in the new light of atomic energy.
10. At Arlington Cemetery with Prime Minister King of Canada, Truman and Attlee pause on Armistice Day, to honor their war dead.
16. The President places a wreath on the tomb of the Unknown Soldier of World War I. *The two prime Ministers repeated this gesture. I, a deeply symbolic gesture. Today, millions of new dead lie in the earth. Nearby is the Canadian War Memorial on which Mr. King place a wreath while Mr. Attlee + Mr. Truman stand by.*
20. Now the three leaders go aboard the Navy yacht Sequoia, to begin discussions.
25. Aboard the Sequoia, Prime Minster Attlee reportedly put forth his plan for pooling the atom secret with France and Russia, as safeguards for future peace. The historic new conference moves ahead!
