- 4. Explosive headlines from Washington! At the Senets Office Building, the Pearl Harbor inquiry opens. Quietly standing by are retired hear Admiral Kimmel and Lt. General Short, who held command at Pearl Harbor. A joint congressional committee, headed by Seantor Alben Barkley, begins its investigation. First witnesses are Colonel Bernard Thielen of the Army General Staff and Rear Admiral T.B. Inglis, Chief of Naval Intelligence. Reporters hear Colonel Thielen testify that no army aircraft were ready to fight when the enemy came, although it had been shown that we knew of the Japs' plan to attack us, six months before Pearl Harbor.
