The actual fact is I believe this to be the greatest risk.....that the United States can make in the direction of preserving the peace, I will tell you a conviction of which I am perfectly certain, there is not a single country in Europe who fears strength in the United States. The only thing they fear is that we will go back to what we thought was isolation and do it by dismantling our strength and going back to where we were before. I believe that only strength can cooperate. That's what I believe."
