December 11th, 1945.

Flight over German U.Boats which were used as Targets for the Air Forces. The task was to sink them by Rockets and Depth Charges.

View of the German U.Boats first attack made by Mosquitoes which fired Rockets into the U.Boat. The First U.Boat was sunk by Mosquitoes in 4 1/2 minutes.

The last submarine was attacked and sunk by Heavy Aircraft Sunderland, Liberators and Warwicks.

Depth Charges were dropped for 20 minutes until the U.Boat sank.

ORDER OF ATTACKING A/C. - MOSQUITOES, LIBERATORS, SUNDERLAND,
WARWICK, SUNDERLAND AND WARWICK.
- ROLL 3. LIBERATORS AND WARWICKS OF COASTAL COMMAND AND SUNDERLANDS
OF 201 SQUADRON. SHOTS OF A BAD MISS!
NOTE. ALL THE SUNDERLANDS WERE USING A 150' TYPE BOMB SIGHT
THOUGH THEY MADE THE ATTACKS FROM 500 FT.
- ROLL 4. SEAPLANE TENDER TAKING CREWS OUT TO THE A/C. SCENES &
VARIOUS ANGLES OF THE A/C TAKING PART IN THE EXERCISE.
- ROLL 5. FURTHER SCENES OF CREWS BOARDING A/C.
