Closed since the beginning of the war, the Monte Carlo Sporting Club (Casino) attempts to re-open under bad conditions, rather scarce public. The Principality of sonaco is indeed off limits for the American GI and this is a law that the MPs strictly enforce. Monte Carlo is a rather dead town, greatly hurt by the war, materially speaking (bombings) as well as morally. An effort is being made anyway and on December 22nd in the evening a Gala marked the resopenings of the Season. All services get to work to that end, as well as the manufacturers of "roulettes" and all gambling machines.

Will the gambling devil find its victims in good number or will it have to content itself with some poor system followers?

They all sit down and the game begins, various shots. Roulette factories, women sewing colors and numbers on the carpets.
