2. Out of the Far East comes the story of one more voyage home -- the voyage back to Korea for men and women who are bidding a final farewell to the Japanese. Uncounted thousands of them were slave laborers for the Japs. Now, aboard American landing craft, family life goes on.
10. There were 999 Koreans counted when the trip began. Two babies were born en route, to raise the number to a thousand and one. Then, Korea ahead -- shores many of these people have not seen in years.
16. They come back to a country now under joint Russian and American occupation. For 35 years a Japanese colony, it has recently been the scene of frequent conferences to meet the complex problems of its government.
23. And like all the displaced, uprooted millions in country after country in both the Pacific and in Europe, these castaways of war go back to find their roots, their homes, once more.
