EVA BRAUN:

Discovered by Allies in Germany! First pictures,
woman Hitler married on eve of suicide.

Out of the wreckage of Hitler's Germany comes one of the most amazing intimate film-records of modern times. Discovered by U.S. Army investigators, these films are the private motion pictures of Eva Braun, who for ten years was the Nazi dictator's close friend, the Number One woman in his life.

Eva, who had an apartment next to Hitler's at Berchtesgaden, was an obsessive gymnast and athlete. She passionately collected movies of herself. Most of these films were made in 1938, 39 and 40, made expressly for her by Hitler's official photographer.

Rumoured to have been married 48 hours before the fall of Berlin, Nazis reported their bodies were burned here in the capital, immediately after they purportedly swallowed poison. But there is still not a single shred of evidence that proves Hitler and Eva Braun are dead.

Today, the wreckage of Berchtesgaden still holds many a secret of Hitler and Eva, dead, or perhaps, alive.
