French Army Reenforcements Arrive at Saigon : 135 ft. developed lavender

Disembarking from the French boat "Ile de Franc", French Army reenforcements parade in Saigon in front of the Admiral Thierry d'Argenlieu, High Commissioner in Indo China. They are mostly from the Foreign Legion.

French Army at Hué - 210 feet developed lavender

Different scenes of newly taken spots in Hué where the Vietnamese Army is still holding part of the town.

Ceremony of the Sacred Elephants - 115 feet developed lavender
In Cambodgia where the King has proved his fidelity to France from the beginning of the fighting, a pictorial ceremony takes place every year when an elephant is sacred and offered to the King.
