COMPLETE DESCRIPTION OF SCENES.

The Viceroy-designate, Viscount Mountbatten and Viscountess Mountbatten landed at Palam Airfield on Saturday, March the 22nd at 3-20 P.M. A Salute of 31 guns was fired on arrival. They were received at aerodrome by Pandit Nehru, Mr. Liaquat Ali Khan, Sir Claude Auchinleck and other distinguished officers. A combined Guard of Honour of the R.A.F. and R.I.A.F and the 9/14 Punjab Regiment was presented before the departure from the Palam Airfield. On arrival inside the Main Gates at the Viceroy's House, the Viceroy designate received a Royal salute from the Governor General's Body Guard. Thereafter the Viceroy designate and Lady Mountbatten attended by the Military Secretary and an A.D.C. drove in state to the foot of the Durbar Hall. After inspecting the Guard of Honour of the Royal Scot Fusiliars, the Viceroy-designate and Lady Mountbatten ascended the Durbar Hall steps where they were received at the top by the Viceroy and Lady Wavel who conducted them into the Viceroy's House.

Reel. 1.

A salute of 31 guns was fired on the arrival of the Viceroy-designate. On coming out from the plane, the Lord and Lady Mountbatten were received by the Military Secretary and the Private Secretary to the Viceroy. Later they were introduced to Pandit Nehru, Mr. Liaquat Ali, the C-in-C and other important officials. Shot of the Commander-in-Chief with Lord Mountbatten arriving. After the Royal Salute, the Viceroy-designate inspected the Guard of Honour of the R.A.F, RIAF and the 9/14 Punjab Regiment. Shot of number of spectators who were present at the airfield.

Reel. 2.

Shot of the Governor General's Body Guard. Arrival of Lord and Lady Mountbatten in the Main Gate of the Viceroy's House. Lord Mountbatten takes Royal Salute. Shot of lancers. Shot of Lord and Lady Mountbatten attended by the Military Secretary and an A.D.C. entering the State carriage.

Reel. 3.

Long shot of the arrival of the State coach. After coming out of the coach, the Viceroy-designate takes Royal Salute. The Viceroy then inspected the Guard of Honour of the Royal Scots Fusiliars. Close Up - the Viceroy-designate inspecting the Guard of Honour.

On the 23rd Morning Lord and Lady Wavell departed from New Delhi. At the Viceroy's House Pandit Nehru and other distinguished persons were present at the Viceroy's House when Lord Wavell accompanied by Lady Wavel drove in State carriage upto the main gate of the Viceroy's House. At the Airodrome Lord and Lady Mountbatten with daughter arrived to say goodby.

Reel. 1.

Long Shot of the Viceroy's House with the Governer General's Body Guard lined up in front.

Shot of the Viceroy's House servants who were witnessing the departure with a heavy heart. Mid shot.

Shot of Pandit Nehru ~~at~~ extreme right with some Indian princes who were present in the Viceroy's House.

Long Shot of the state carriage arriving. Mid Shot.

Lady Wavell speaking to friend who had come to wish goodby.

Lord Wavell with Sir Claude Auchenleck.

Lord Wavell with Lord Mountbatten. Lord and Lady Wavel with Lord and Lady Mountbatten. A group of the Viceroy designate and the outgoing Viceroy. It is for the first time in the history of India that two Viceroy's were present in the capitol of India.
