Muslims demanding a separate Muslim state, Pakistan, lined the route when the Vicercy met the tribesmen of the Khyber Pass, on his visit to the North West frontier. The Africai elders presented him with a rifle of their own manufacture and a leather haversack of the kind they wear in mountain warfare. They pressed for wonership of the Kryber Pass when we leave India. Beturning by way of Kahuta, Lord Mountbatten saw the devastation inflicted on the town in the riots of a few weeks ago; vivid proof that Hindu and Muslim are a long way from the united India we hoped to leave behind.
