He is greeted by the negro Mayor of Dakar. President is greeting negro mayors and personalities that are sitting. President, with the Dakar Mayor, leaving in a car then laying a wreath on the monument to killed soldiers.

President Auriol in St.Louis (Some 270 km. from Dakar). President crossing a bridge and laying a wreath. General view of the place with tremendous crowd. Then military parade with camels, spahis.

Then President is breaking ground where a school for 1,500 children will be built.
