COMPLETE DESCRIPTION OF SCENES.

These holidays were rather spoiled by very unsettled weather. For instance on Sunday due to poor weather after midday, the usual hiking and picnicking spots of Derbyshire were virtually deserted. Today, rain after breakfast put many people off though the day cleared wonderfully later.. By far the biggest rush has been to Blackpool and the other resorts for the day.

This material, apart from the caravan sequence was shot in the Lakes. With the early rain it started off as a wet weather story but the bright idea had to be abandoned.

ROLL ONE. Opens with ~~general~~ shots of woman cooking in caravan, then generals of the camp of the British Caravaners Club. then a couple of -hots meant as a gag. The idea was "caravanning is fine, the wife does all the work whilst the man well ~~an-~~ sleeps over "Forever Amber".

Scenes at Boness on Lake Windermere, various shots of the lake steamer leaving, rowing boats, racing yachts etc

ROLL TWO. Opens with wet weather scenes in the hills behind Grasmere. Then shots of lone hiker and odd shot of party setting off for hills. Shots on Kirkstone Pass mainly showing vehicles struggling up the climb. The idea was "Some people take to the hills on their own, some go in groups, whilst others are taken round".

ROLL THREE. EYEMO ROLL.
"Snoop" shots of people picnicking and lying in sun. Also shows very heavy road traffic with plane—presumably Lancs County Police control plane, flying low along route.
