

INTERVIEW WITH MR. CALDWELL,
AUSTRALIAN MINISTER IMMIGRATION.

SV Mr. C. seated desk.

["Australia believes that the world's finest export always has been and always will be men and women of British stock. It is on British stock that the Australian Commonwealth was founded. Australia wants more and more population from Britain;] we need about 20 million people in Australia if we are to hold our island continent for ourselves and our descendants."

SV as above

"Australia believes and always will believe that the best export the people of Britain can send to our country are British men and women. Australia was founded on British stock and Australia needs more and more people from Britain if she is to survive in the future. We need to build our population to 20 million, and we hope that many men and women and children from Britain will be able to come to Australia in the next few years."

SCU ["We want men and women with courage and enterprise. We will welcome them because this is a birthright of the British people, even if they haven't a penny in their pocket.] All we ask is that they shall be prepared to work hard and help to build the economy of the great Australian nation."

CU In the whole of our 3 million sq. miles of territory, which is 25 times the size of Gt. Britain, and Ireland, there are fewer people living than are to be found in the great overcrowded metropolis of

of the British Empire. [We need a vastly increased population else we shall not survive. We ask you to come to the land of sunshine and plenty of good food, and you will be welcome, provided you are prepared to work and do your part with others in making the Australia of the future.]

INTERVIEW MRS. SLEE
(NO MORE BABIES CAMPAIGN.)

SV Mrs. S. at desk.

My message to the parents of children in starving countries is to declare a moratorium on the birthrate for the next ten years. Why? Some friends ask, should you say ten years. Why? Because I profoundly believe it is going to take from six to ten years for the world to gain its equilibrium from the chaos, the poverty, the misery, the disease in which it has gone and is still going thru. We must know that conditions of this kind are in no way conducive to healthy, happy children. [Parents should not bring children into this world until conditions are made better for their upbringing, for their health, for their security and their development.

SCU (Women of all war-torn countries like me ^{that they} are giving birth to death, not to life.]

SCU ditto

It seems not only cruel, unfair, unjust, to allow children to be born in these conditions. It is unfair and cruel, not only to those that are born but those who may be unborn. And so I say and call out to the
