COMPLETE DESCRIPTION OF SCENES.

Light conditions extremely variable throughout day - in some shots even a light change may be observed.

ROLL ONE. Opens with some scenes of the procession of decorated vehicles, with Leeds Town Hall in the background. Possibly odd shots of sports before mag jam.

ROLL TWO. The crowning of the "QUEEN OF CHILDREN'S DAY", 11 year old Pamela Hopper, by the Lady Mayoress of Leeds, Lady Martin. She is escorted to and from the platform by her retinue, and the Lord Mayor (Sir George Martin), and other high civic and police officials. Run out on sports shots including obstacle race. (here after going under the net the finish is by a short "sack race" A finish shot is detailed later.

ROLL THREE. More sports scenes, after a short section of girls sports comes an odd shot of the finish of the boys obstacle race to tack on to Roll Two. Broad general views of the natural amphitheatre in Roundhay park, Leeds, in which the event was held, the arena is filled with a massed physical culture display by boys and girls.

ROLL FOUR. A few crowd shots. General view and closer shots of country dancing display. Roll ends on a few crowd cut-ins.

GENERAL STORY.

In windy and somewhat inclement weather, Leeds celebrated CHILDREN'S DAY an event unique event in England. In the morning a procession of gaily decorated vehicles took children in fancy dress from Leeds Town Hall, to Roundhay Park on the outskirts where the main celebrations took place. Many thousands of people turned up (though I am informed that the show and crowd was not up to standard, doubtless due to the weather.)
