Roll 1 (50ft)	A buoy being taken out in a boat to be put in position. "Bluebird" being brought out of the shed, backwards. The stem on starting up - in case there was a good flame.	[NOTE. The fin is in front of the rudder, in front of the newspaper]
Roll 2	Fueling scenes. The "cockpit" 3 scenes. A mechanic showing the new fin (keel) & the rudder which is now smaller. 2 scenes of buoys being taken to the water.	
Roll 3	Campbell getting ready and getting in Bluebird. The craft going down the slip into the water.	
Roll 4	Bluebird starting up with a lot of smoke etc. moving off with spray.	
Roll 5	Bluebird at speed with aircraft in one shot. Campbell coming ashore. Bluebird being brought up the slip. Some of the mechanics & Campbell's daughter.
