8. General view of the dining room and close of Mrs. Laydon as she phones down to the summer house to Shaw to tell him his lunch is ready.
9. Shaw's study and close ups of his desk and books
10. Close of his meal ready for him
11. Dr. Lowenstein, who is writing his biography goes down to the summer house to see Shaw-Shaw is annoyed when he spots me
