Sequences required:-

1. Polish troops in the mass, (to lend pictorial backing on the statement of numbers).

(If we show the best camps, dressed for the occasion, we shall do the Poles an injustice. We would prefer to show poorer quarters, since reaction would be more of sympathy than of envy.
3. Close-ups of Polish types, (to show that they are normal acceptable folk. We would prefer to show fine types rather than average.
4. Sound interviews in the case of (3) to enable us to punch home their trade qualifications. In answer to a commentator's question, we should like to show a rapid sequence of good faces where each man states his qualification, i.e. miner, carpenter, farm worker, etc.
