COMPLETE DESCRIPTION OF SCENES.

The location is at the Southmead Hospital just outside Bristol.

The building was the wartime Army Blood Bank. It is now the M.O.H.  
S.W. regional Blood Transfusion Centre.

Scenes show:-

The arrival of the van with Nelson's Blood. It is off loaded and put straight away in the cold chamber, which is at 4 deg Centigrade. The blood is also grouped, and the girl is seen doing part of the test to ascertain the groups. The small frig door which is opened contains blood of the universal group and is kept apart for rush cases and night emergencies.
