Some of the fourteen thousand Displaced Persons who are still at Belsen made a strong protest against bringing the Exodus refugees to Germany. Enlightened public opinion throughout the world is puzzled by the decision to take the illegal Palestine immigrants to Germany of all countries. [Displaced Persons here, by the way, do not occupy the former Concentration Camp, but the well-appointed buildings which were the S.S. <sup>qu</sup> barracks.
