From Trieste, former Italian port ~~which comes under~~ United Nations' control, by the peace treaty with Italy, comes news of unrest; a repetition of disorders such as these filmed some months ago. Meanwhile General Steele, commanding British troops in Austria, crossed the border into Yugoslavia on the eve of ~~relinquishing his command~~ *returning home* to take up his new appointment of Adjutant-General to the Forces. At Bled, on the frontier, the General inspected the Yugoslav guard of honour formed by troops modelled on the Red Army.

The British commander was then conducted to the new country residence of Marshal Tito, ~~built on the site of head-quarters once destroyed by the Gestapo~~. There has been some tension between Yugoslavs and British occupation forces and the Foreign Office demands the immediate release of men still in Yugoslav detention camps. May this meeting between General Steele and the Marshal have done something to restore friendship with our good wartime allies.
