	<p>Due to a shortage of milk in the south of England (in particular) supplies from the Liverpool area are being sent south, whilst Liverpool is receiving extra supplies by air from Belfast. A daily shuttle service, milk one way, empty cans the other is being operated by British European Airways using a York and a Lancastrian belonging to Skyways Ltd. The planes do up to four round trips a day carrying a total of 10,000 to 11,000 gallons daily.</p> <p>ROLL ONE. The Lancastrian arrives. This roll jammed a bit and also did not appear to run too steadily. However I send it on in case there are any usable scenes.</p> <p>ROLL TWO. Several shots of the arrival of the York aircraft g.v. showing both machines from rear. Couple of shots of empties going into Lancastrian Front gv, shows particularly York with unloading in progress. Various scenes of unloading cans on to lorry. Couple of shots of Lancastrian starting up and taxiing away for next trip. Run out on lorry moving away from York.</p> <p>(notes. This story would have been improved by going over to Belfast, but due to engine troubles with machines this could not be fitted in today. Due also the technical hitches, on lone run took place in the late morning and afternoon today, the planes arriving in the early evening. Had normal conditions been operating it would have been possible to get additional good shots on other trips which would have improved matters a bit.)</p>
