Dear Sir and Brother,

We shall hold our **Annual Toy Service on Sunday, October 12th at 3 o'clock,** and I confidently rely on your support as on all previous occasions now covering a period of 27 years, during which you have enabled me to send 19,617 Toys to various Hospitals listed above. I do not know what the general effect will be when the hospitals come under Government control, but I am sure that toys will still be needed for sick children.

BISHOP NEVILLE LOVETT has kindly consented to come and preach. He is well known to most of us as the first Bishop of Portsmouth and afterwards Bishop of Salisbury. He is no stranger to a Toy Service, since he came to us for that purpose at Titchfield 13 years ago.

The Lord Mayor and Lady Mayoress of Portsmouth have accepted my invitation to be present and I hope the Mayors of Gosport, Southampton and Winchester will be present and representatives of the Urban and Rural Councils of Petersfield, since hospitals in all these places benefit from our service.

I hope to secure a Band and the Procession will start from our Institute at 2.40 p.m.
