- SOUND - (1) Princess Elizabeth accompanied by Lt. Mountbatten walks down slipway and inspects ship, escorted by Mr. F.A. Bates of Cunard.
- (2) Elizabeth and Philip standing together on platform as National Anthem is played.
- (3) Princess Elizabeth's speech followed by Launch - bottle breaking.
- (4) Ship moves down slipway.
- (5) Elizabeth and Philip talk with workmen who built 'Caronia'.
- SILENT - Wide angle crowd shots from sound camera position.
