| | A record figure of more than 2,000 persons sought asylum in the western sectors a few days ago, jamming the 74 West Berlin refugee camps already critically overcrowded. There are 30,000 refugees now in camps in West Berlin. Refugees are screened here and the screening process takes four to six weeks. If accepted the refugees are flown out to West Germany by a special air-lift provided by commercial air lines. | | | |
