

VENICE COURT IMPOUNDS OIL FROM ABADAN

The Italian Tanker Miriella brought 4,500 tons  
of fuel oil from Abadan. It was piped into storage tanks  
and impounded there for 15 days<sup>a</sup> waiting the  
decision of the Civil Court. The Italian importers  
bought the oil from the Nationalised Persian Company,  
but Anglo-Iranian claim that <sup>it's</sup> ~~the oil is~~ their property.
