COMPLETE DESCRIPTION OF SCENES

On the hand camera, shots at jump three on the previous race to the Coronation Cup, this race run in two sections, owing to the large numbers of entries. Shots at the jump and falls. After this various shots of the Queen in jeep etc and and being introduced to Gould the course jump erecter etc aged 72...he points out various points of the fences to the Queen, then crowd shots etc etc and finally finishing on the start of the second leg of the Coronation Cup.

On the other camera some way back from the course (as far as it was possible to get, owing to the ground being cultivated, and having to work from this side of the course, because the Queen was expected to visit this side, one or two pans of the Coronation Cup race and also a start, finishing on a gen view looking towards the stands etc.

What with various restrictions owing to the Queen being there, and the other companies, i.e., Newsreels being in full force, and no information as to where the Queen was likely to go, one was left wondering what to do for the best.

It was purely luck that I waited at the Jump No 3, and the Queen came there. Race card attached.
