	Note. Rolls are numbered with punch marks.
1.	The high spot of the show -the Coronation Cavalcade, a small scale replica of the Coronation Coach complete with outriders & attendants. General view.
2.	Repeat general view with 18mm lens as a test.
3.	Close up angles on the coach & riders.
4.	Inside the gardens -girls admiring & picking the flowers with close of girls and carnations
5.	A new idea in cupboards -girl shows an ordinary kitchen cupboard and then shows a corner cupboard which reveals making it so easy to get at things. Semi view ' close.
6.	Labour saving kitchen equipment -sink with a disposal bin underneath operated by the foot and with a small tea trolley tucked away ready for convenient use. Semi view with close ups of foot operating pedal of disposal bin.
7.	A large 'cuckoo clock' display -- but advertising a tiny electric oven for the flatlet or for a quick simple meal. Pan from the 'pendulem' up to two little figures as cooks which pop out ( there is a background voice which says 'Your cook- your cook!)
