Small Section of "I" Force (see cutting) consisting of men of the Kenya Regt. and several Turkhama trackers armed with spears proceed on patrol in the Aberdare mountains. They discover a terrorist hideout and surround it, Entry is made into the huts and Mau Mau found inside are arrested, disarmed, and led way to clearing in forest where they are interrogated. As patrols in the Aberdares are inaccessible by any other means, foed etc. supplies are dropped by air. Scene of an airdrop is shown.

Aerial view of Mount Kenya takenthe following day - by plane sent to recce slopes of My. Kenya and to discover whether there were any caves visible which Mau Mau might be using. Did discover caves (hope these are clearly visible) Also shows European farms in relation to the mountain and the forest belt.

"I" Force, during operations on Mount Kenya systematically brin down all huts on fringe of forest to prevent their use as shelter for Mau Mau. One of these burning huts is shown.

Complete sequence of the Lancashire Fusiliers going out on anti-Mau Mau patrol. Beginning at Operational H.Q. where radio message is received - course of action is plotted on map. O.C. "D" Coy. Lanc. Fus. shown pointing to map area on mapwhere, according to information received, Mau Mau are hiding. Lieut. P. Ward is instructed to proceed with his platoon to this area and raid huts. Accompanied by Kenya Police Reserve men and African askaris fo the Kenya Police, the platoon departs at dawn and Emproceeds to the area to be raided. On arrival personnel debus and continue on foot through forest. On sight of huts the party breaks up into small detachments and surround huts, At given signal from Lieut. Ward on minimized whistle all huts are entered simultaneously by Kenya Police african personnel while fusiliers stand by in case of attempted escape. Five terrorists are arrested - one of them is sen ebing disarmed of his Simi (large, sharp knife) by one of the Lanc. Fus. men. Prisoners are them assembled and Major Heron-Bruce conducts an on -the-spot screening. Three of the five are found to be Mau Mau and are stood aside while the other two are taken to H.Q. for further screening.
