CRASH LANDING! COAST GUARD RESCUES 10 NAVY FLIERS

A U.S. Navy Neptune patrol-bomber in the Atlantic midway between Bermuda and the Azores ..., one engine out, the second spitting oil. A crash landing, near the Coast Guard Cutter "Coos Bay", which picked up the distress signal, while on patrol duty, and by radio guided the plane down. Its ten arewmen await rescue ... a Goast Grardsman keeps trigger-eye alert against sharks as the fliers are lifted out — four from the water, six off the plane's emergency raft.

These films made by coast guard personnel show in graphic form how the network of floating Atlantic emergency stations is paying off. Radar tracked the stricken plane — the rescue came within 35 minutes after the craft crash-landed.

And so, men are smatched from a watery grave; happy ending to a rescue drama in the mid-Atlantic;
