Rolls punched marked one, two & three.

Roll one starts off with various crowd shots, cup tie enthusiasts the teams come out, the Hibernians first, followed by Aberdeen, the manager of Aberdeen, a Mr Mitchell shakes hands with the captain.

The first shot on this roll is a close up of Jimmy Murray, who saw or watched Hibernians play in 1879.

Shots follow with play from The Aberdeen goal.

Roll two continues from the same position, fingers across lens denotes half time, then the rest of this roll and roll three continues from the Hibs goal.

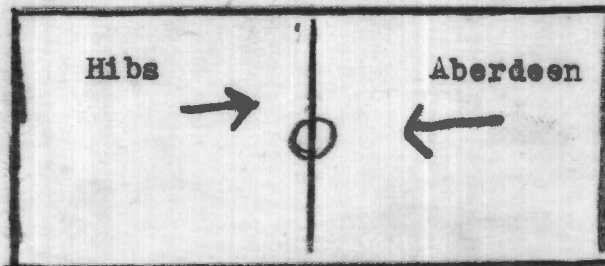
This goal line position was very poor, much too close, but it was the only position that the police would allow, and very definite about it.
