

RETURN OF PRESIDENT TITO TO HIS COUNTRY

"Galeb", which sailed into the Yugoslav waters, was receiving many greetings and messages, addressed to President Tito. They were chiefly greetings of Tito's mariners and flyers, and then, they were also greetings of occasional by-passers. After his fortnight trip, on which he successfully filled his task of a statesman, Marshal Tito was returning to his country to share his joy of success with his collaborators and the whole people.

It was a nice sunny day on the 30th March.

Thousands and thousands of citizens from Split and its neighbourhood gathered on the pier "Gat proleterskih brigada" waiting the arrival of President and sending their hearty greetings towards "Galeb" on the wings of the warm Adriatic breeze.

At 4.00 p.m. punctually, accompanied by destroyers, "Galeb" sailed into the Split port. At that moment Tito was greeted by all the ships anchored in the port with sharp sirene sounds, which mixed with merry ovations and applauses of the gathered crowds.

On the "Gat proleterskih brigada" Tito was welcomed and greeted by deput chairman of the Federal Executive Committee Aleksandar Ranković, ~~president of the Government of the People's Republic Croatia Vladimir Bakarić, president of the Government of the People's Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina Djuro Pucar and other high state officials.~~

~~In the name of citizens of Split President Tito was greeted by the chairman of the Municipal People's Committee.~~

Then, with almost incessant interruptions of stormy ovations, Marshal Tito made a brief address, giving his impressions from Great Britain. "There we realized of how a great importance was this visit to Great Britain. First and foremost thing is that, even for such a short period, we could feel the soul of British people and make us assured that it was not by chance that in 1948, in those most difficult moments, when we were left alone, that people, together with its responsible personalities, offered us its help, as it was also done by many other western peoples. It was not a calculated speculation, it was expression of those ties which were created during two great world conflicts and which, I firmly believe, will be lasting; we made us assured there that the desire of British people for peace is as burning as ours," said President Tito.

This address of President Tito was followed by expressions of sympathy and desire for strengthening of British - Yugoslav friendship and for establishment of peace in the world.
