Due to various announcements from official sources that people especially in the Nairobi area should be more alert for the next ten days - Security Forces patrols have been stepped up, especially so in the suburbs where women and children remain alone while their menfolk are away at work in the city.

Picture shows "round the cleck" activities by security forces - barhed wire defences being erected round a typical suburban police station, Kenya Police Reserve patrols stopping all suspicious vehicles and Africans for checking, a night patrol of the homeguard visiting a home, and later stopping cars, and a day patrol by homeguards visiting a home where a wife and children can be seen having a meal (gun can be seen to hand on table) and finally the homeguard checking the African servants quarters to ensure that no undesirables are being harboured by them.
