Wrecked in the Cascade Mountains by engine failure - a troop transport plane ^{carrying} ~~carrying~~ 25 soldiers. Six were killed. 19 were still living when a helicopter dropped a rescue squad. That all were not killed was because the plane's fall was broken by trees. Even then, isolated at 3,000-ft., the rest might have frozen to death if the helicopter hadn't found them. The injured were rushed back to hospital near Seattle .
