20" stuff on follows down the fast straight "Hangar Straight"

20" shot of the incident of No.32 A.M. Bryde driving a Cooper Bristol, jumps out as the car catches fire, but is quickly put out with extinguishers (Exclusive).

Various shots on the "Maggots Curve" and Becketts Corner.

10" stuff close up Drivers sawing their way round the Corners.

Couple of crowd cut ins.

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Daily Express took down the only Tower that was of any use, so all material taken from the Sound Truck.

Not a very exciting Race.
