Shot of the State coach carrying Col. Hunt, Hillary, Tenzing and his family, moving in the procession.

Long Shot of the procession . Shots of the people going in trucks and shouting slogans in honour of Hillary and Tenzing.

Inbetween there are few shots of crowd and a medium shot of people watching procession. Girls on horse back also marched in the procession.

There is also a shot where the British Ambassador, High Officials of the Nepalese Army, the Nepalese Premier and other important personalities are waiting for the arrival of the procession.
