In state procession along majestic Princes Street the Queen and the Duke of Edinburgh drove ~~from~~ to St Giles Cathdrl to the service of Thanksgiving and Dedication.

57 At St. Giles, hisotric high kirk of Edinburgh, the Honours of Scotland (Crown, Sword and Sceptre) were borne before Her Majesty and laid on the Holy Table.

The Dean of the Chapel Royal present<sup>ed</sup> the Honours to the Queen; first the Crown of Scotland. The ~~honor~~ privilege of bearing it fell to the Duke of Hamilton. At this service Her Majesty dedicated herself to her Scotttish people; they avowed their loyalty to her.
