COMPLETE DESCRIPTION OF SCENES

Admiring crowd burst through Safdar Jang Airport barriers and a police cordon to welcome Sir John Hiunt, Tenzing and Admund Hillary on their arrival in New Delhi on Sunday. Wild clapping of hands and ecstatic shouts which greeted the everest expedition members as they alighted from the planr which brought them from Calcutta, were followed by a stempade by the crowds that had thronged the airstation since early afternoon to catch a fleeting glimpse of Tenzing and Hillary.

Sir John Hunt held aloft the historic ice-axe with which Sir Edmund and Tenzing had hacked their way upto the sumit of the Mount Everest.

To the axe was tied the Indian Tricilour which Tanzing had secretly carried to the top of the highest mountain in the world to waive it their with the flags of the United Nations, Jinuted Kingdom and Nepal.

On Monday morning The Everest Climbers were welcomed by the Delhi City Corporation where after an address of Wecome the Heroes were presented with replicas of HXMAX Mount Everest (in silver) and Ashoka's Pillar which is the official insignia of the Government of India. On arrival the Everest climbers were garlanded by the President of the corporation. After receiving the welcome address, the leader addressed the gathering and it was amusing and surprise for the public when suddenly after English, Sit Hunt swtiched on to Hindustani (Indian language) Sir Hunt was Followed by Tenzing and Hillary spoke in the end.

INDIA PRESENTS GOLD MEDALS TO EVEREST CLIMBERS

THE LEADER OF THE BRITISH EVEREST EXPEDITION, COL. SIR JOHN HUNT, AND TENZING AND SIR EDMUND HILLARY, THE TWO MEMBERS OF HIS PARTY WHO CLIMBED THE SUMMIT, WERE ON MONDAY PRESENTED SPECIAL GOLD MEDALS BY THE PRESIDENT IN RECOGNITION OF THEIR "MAGNIFICENT ACHIEVEMENT" AT A COLOURFUL AND UNIQUE INVESTITURE HELD IN THE RED-EARTH FORECOURT OF THE PRESIDENT'S HOUSE.

Addressing the large and distinguished gathering present to honour these men and their colleagues of the expedition, the President Dr. Rajindra Prasad, said it was the splendid spirit of comradeship, and cooperation shown by the members of the expedition, who represented four nationalities, that could bring peace to mankind.

He hoped that the spirit of enterprise and adventure that had enabled the expedition to gain the summit of Everest would continue to inspire the humanity to greater and higher conquests of nature.

Sir John's citation reffered to his inspiring leadership, unselfish determination and unfailing energy. The citations of Tenzing and Hillary reffered to their mountaineering experience and enumarated the special qualities that distinguished them their effort - skill, courage and resolution.

As the citations were read, the three men in turn rose from their seats and advanced over a red carpet towards the dias to receive the medals from the President. All three were warmly applauded.

"Adventure is Glory" is the moto engraved on the medals.

The minister of Education, Moulana Azad introduced the expedition and the mountain to the President and the audience.

At the end of the ceremony India's Prime Minister Nehru mixed with the members of the expedition .
