2. SCRUB THIS ONE OUT (a 100yds. shot by mistake in the hurry of shifting)
3. Crowd cut-ins
- ✓ 4. The 100 yds. start & follow part way -won by J.Schatzle of U.S.A.
- ✓ 5. Different lenses on the 880 yds. ~~XXXX~~ won by M.G.Whitefield of U.S.A.
6. Shot of clock (this only to split up two races)
- ✓ 7. The 440yds. won by J.W.Mashburn of U.S.A. (practically only one figure comes into the picture of the final lap)
8. Two shots of Miss S.Lowwill attempting to set new record for the ladies' high jump. (This shot to cover for Dudley who was busy elsewhere).
9. Different lenses on the four one time holders of the mile record as they are taken round the track in car. (see program)
10. Various lenses on the one mile race with exciting finish when Pirie overtakes the American -in the previous laps Chattaway was laying 2nd. with Nankeville somewhere
11. Pirie runs round track afterwards & acknowledges the cheers of the crowd.
12. The 3 miles race --various lenses with Sando, Binnie, Green and the Belgian Herman changing places and finally the Belgian sprinting to the fore and finishing very strongly to win.
